<b>Teaching and Learning</b>	Intervention groups with TA support	£9600	All pupils in receipt of PP were able to access specific TA led support. 57% of children in receipt of PP attained at a secure level in their year group. Of the 43% who did not attain the secure level for their year group, 19% are on the SEND register. Of the remaining children, all made good progress from their starting point.
	Y2 & Y6 booster programmes	£4000	In Year 6 60% of children in receipt of PP secured the EXS or better in all areas. 20% of the children secured the EXS in all areas apart from Reading (missing out by 1 mark). The remaining 20% is on the SEND register and there are specific learning barriers. In
	1 to 1 tutoring and mentoring	£4000	80% of the children in receipt of PP who received 1 to 1 secured the EXS in Writing and Maths. 60% of children in receipt of PP secured the EXS or better in all areas.
	CatchUp intervention and training	£5000	All children in receipt of PP were targeted with CatchUp intervention. This had a positive impact upon all learners.
