



# Year 3 Curriculum Newsletter

## Terms 1 and 2 – Wish You Were Here?



Our learning this term is based around the exciting challenge of designing and creating our own coastal locations! Our new locations will need to include physical features, sea defences and features that take into account the views of different people who might visit our resort. In our Literacy we will learn about the features of persuasive writing and create posters to persuade people to visit our locations.

In Art we will be painting coastal scenes based on photographs from our trip and in Music we will be learning and performing sea shanties.

We look forward to sharing our learning with you at our celebration which will be held near the end of Term 2.

The core areas of learning for this term are:

### **Numeracy - Mental Maths**

3 x table, including division facts.  
Reading 3 digit numbers.  
Partitioning 3 digit numbers.  
Ordering and comparing numbers.  
Counting in 20s, 200s, 2000s.  
Adding multiples of 1000.  
Doubling 2 digit numbers.  
Halving multiples of 100.  
Multiplying and dividing by 10.

### **Numeracy – Main Maths**

Numbers to 1000.  
Addition and subtraction.  
Multiplication and division.

### **Science**

#### **Forces – Magnets**

Investigating how magnets work.  
Investigating attraction and repulsion.  
Identifying materials that are attracted to magnets.

#### **Electricity**

Constructing electrical circuits.  
Investigating switches.  
Finding out which materials are conductors and insulators.

### **Computing**

Developing our typing skills.  
Stop animations – formation of coastal features.  
Taking photographs and photo editing.  
E-mailing.  
Modelling and simulations – designing a coastal location.  
Programming and control – coding.  
Ongoing use of Word.  
Using the Internet safely.

### **Literacy - Big Reading**

Analysis – Understanding how paragraphs and chapters are used, understanding how e.g. indexes and thesauruses are organised and used.  
Deduction – Making deductions about characters.

Singing and accompanying sea shanties

Understanding, saying, reading and writing new words and phrases linked to greetings, numbers and weather.

**Geography**

Investigating human and physical features of coasts.  
Investigating how environments can be damaged and improved.  
Following maps, creating our own maps.  
Designing our own coastal location.

**History**

History objectives are covered through other topics during the year.

Making fairground rides using electrical components.

**Art and Design**

Paintings based on photographs from our trip.
